Prayer Study Offered

You are invited to join us for a four week study on the topic of prayer. The study will begin on Wednesday night June 24th @ 5:30 p.m. The study will run weekly through Wednesday July 15th. The study will be approximately 30-40 minutes in length and will be held in the fellowship hall. Each study will present a 15-20 minute video followed by 15-20 minutes of discussion. These studies are being offered by the Prayer Team. It is our hope, that you will remain following the study and join with us for a time of prayer in the sanctuary.

The first study is based on the book written by Max Lucado entitled: *Before Amen: The Power of a Simple Prayer.* The book is described on Amazon in the following manner:

"We all pray . . . some. We pray to stay sober, centered, or solvent. When the lump is deemed malignant. When the money runs out before the month does. When the marriage is falling apart. We pray.

But wouldn't we like to pray more? Better? Stronger? With more fire, faith, and fervency?

Yet we have kids to feed, bills to pay, deadlines to meet. The calendar pounces on our good intentions like a tiger on a rabbit. And what about our checkered history with prayer? Uncertain words. Unmet expectations. Unanswered requests.

We aren't the first to struggle with prayer. The first followers of Jesus needed prayer guidance too. In fact, prayer is the only tutorial they ever requested.

And Jesus gave them a prayer. Not a lecture on prayer. Not the doctrine of prayer. He gave them a quotable, repeatable, portable prayer. Couldn't we use the same?

In *Before Amen* best-selling author Max Lucado joins readers on a journey to the very heart of biblical prayer, offering hope for doubts and confidence even for prayer wimps. Distilling prayers in the Bible down to one pocket-sized prayer, Max reminds readers that prayer is not a privilege for the pious nor the art of a chosen few. Prayer is simply a heartfelt conversation between God and his child. Let the conversation begin."

It is the goal of the Prayer Team to help our church better understand the role that prayer plays in both our individual and our corporate lives. We hope that you will join us for this four week study. We also have the possibility of offering similar studies in the months ahead, so we'd really like to gauge how well this kind of study will be received. The videos will be narrated by Max Lucado and should prove to be quite thought provoking.
