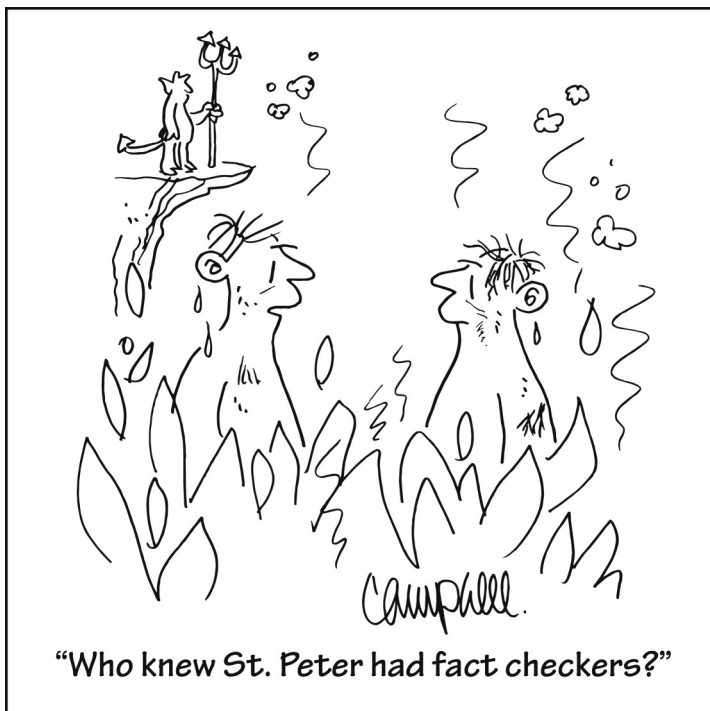


Sunday January 27 through Sunday February 3

Ephesian 2: 1-10

The story of Nancy's friend.

What does it mean to be dead through trespasses and sin?

Remember how sin came into our lives. God walked with Adam and Eve every evening as the new day arrived. You know about the Fruit of the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil. How does eating that fruit cause death? Eve listened to the serpent, not God.

- Eve blamed the serpent.
- Adam listened to Eve, not God.
- Adam blamed God for giving him Eve.
- The fruit of the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil is shame, guilt, and blame.

Who or what is the ruler of the power of the air that is now at work among the disobedient?

- The disobedient still blame Satan.
- The disobedient still blame God.
- The disobedient still blame their neighbor.
- The disobedient believe in God but refuse to listen to The Holy Spirit and See life through the Grace of Jesus Christ

What are the "good works" we are created for In Christ Jesus?

- Confession: Where there is sin we confess Christ.
- Repentance: Those who confess Christ see themselves through God's eyes. Listen to God not Satan or neighbor. God says in Christ you are Holy and Blameless.
- Forgiveness: Remembers Christ's gift of Grace who frees us from every act of disobedience.
- Reconciliation: Holy Communion with Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- Witness: Communion that includes neighbor.

What might happen to friends like Nancy's if we lived the Life God has created for us?
