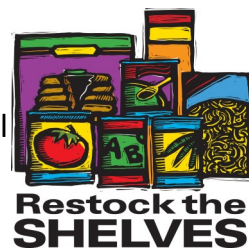


UPS Back Pack Program

Black History Month

Did you know?

Phillis Wheatley was the first published African American female author. She was a servant who published her first poem at the age of 12 in the mid 1700s.

George Washington Carver made several agricultural advances and used the peanut to create over 100 new products.

Benjamin Banneker was a self-taught astronomer who is credited as the first African American scientist.

Thurgood Marshall was the first African American appointed to the Supreme Court.

Claudette Colvin refused to give up her seat on the bus and was taken to jail nine months before Rosa Parks.

Sojourner Truth escaped from slavery in 1826 and became an abolitionist and women's rights activist.

Dr. Patricia Bath is a pioneer ophthalmologist, inventor, and academic who is known for inventing a tool and procedure for the removal of cataracts.

Martha Jones was an inventor and the first known African-American woman to be granted a U.S. patent.

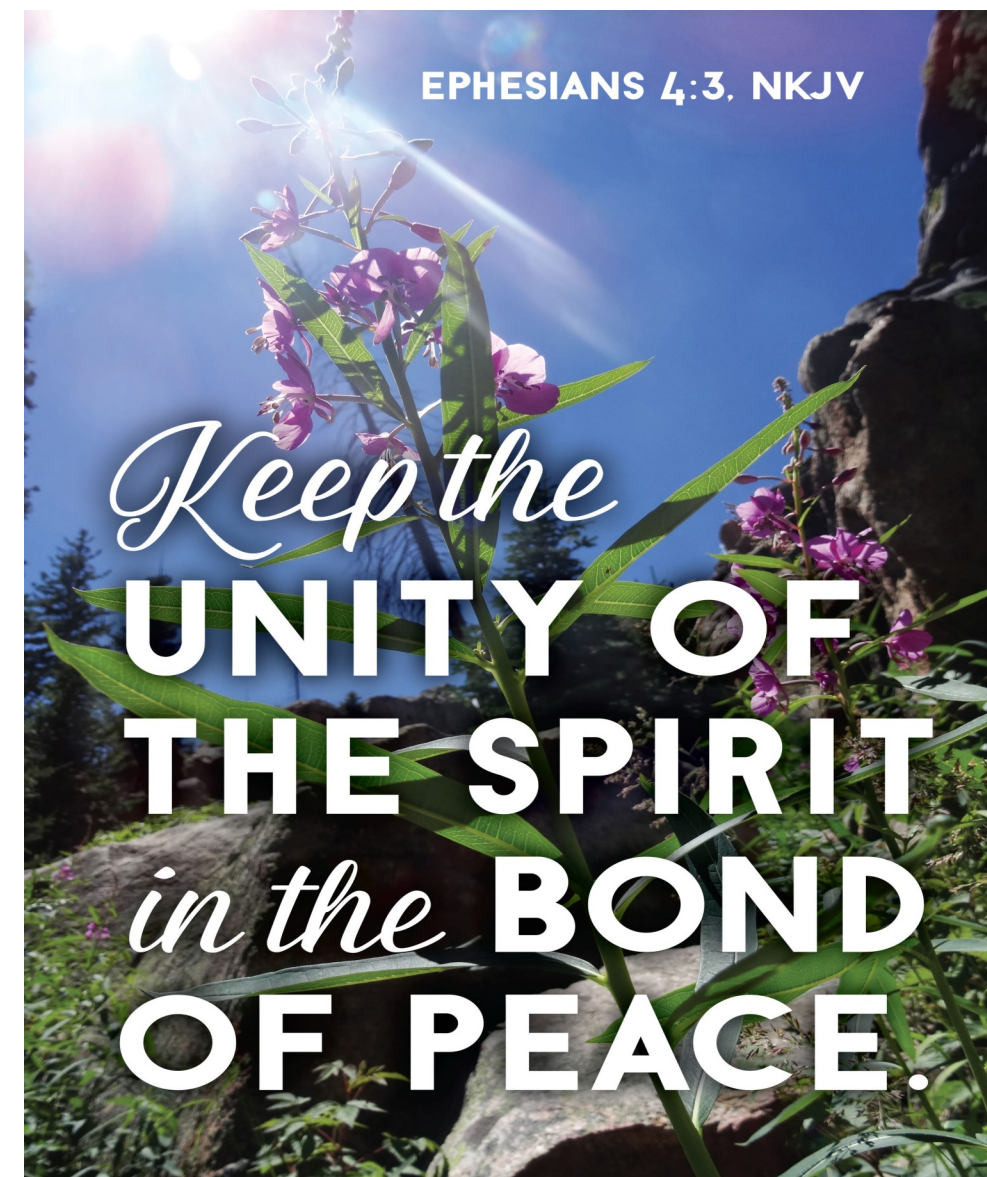

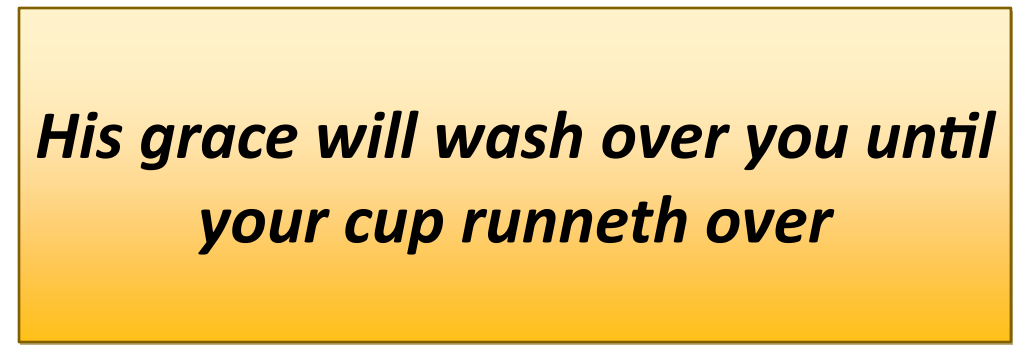
