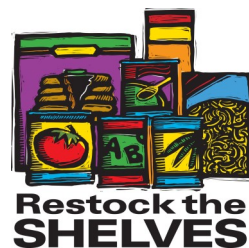


UPS Back Pack Program

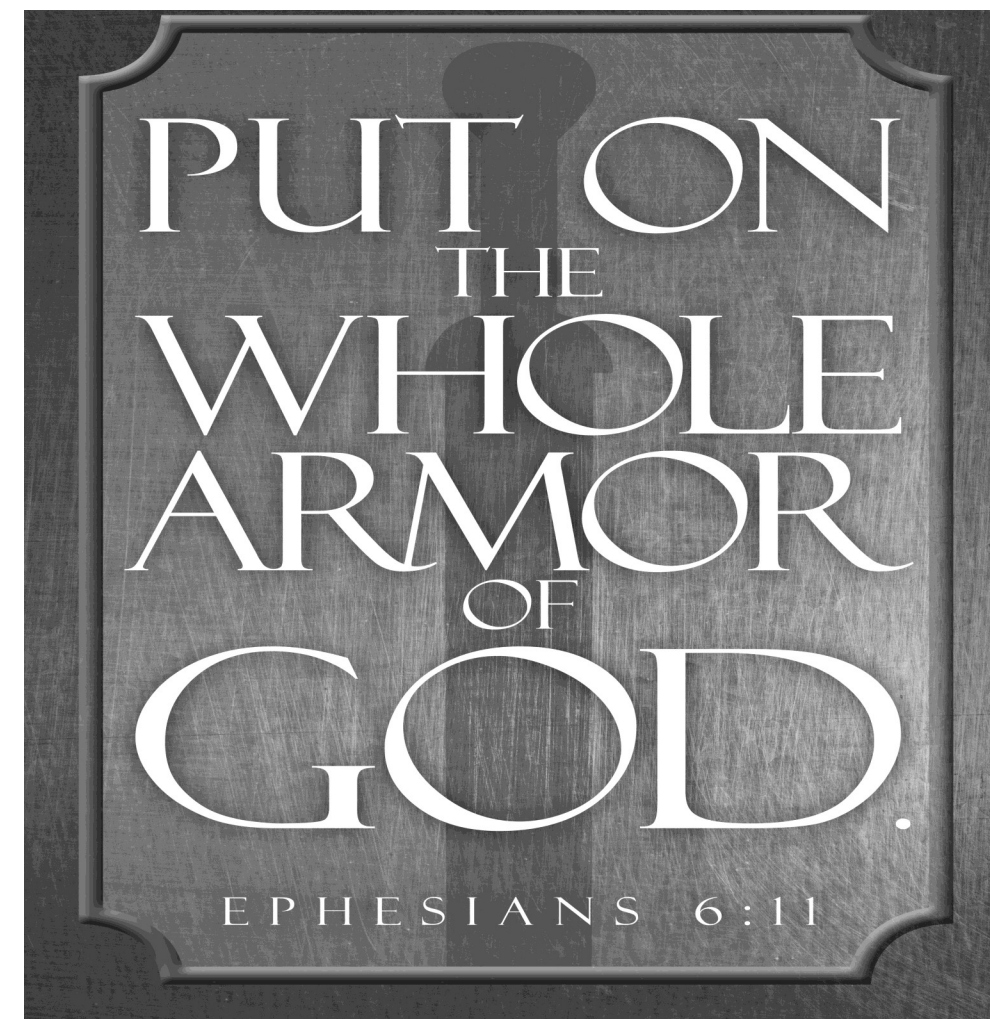

Message: Dressed for Success: The Full Armor of God (The Great Thanksgiving contains my message.)

The Great Thanksgiving

The Lord be in your heart , soul, and mind.

And also in yours.

Lift up your heart, soul, and mind.

We lift them up to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to be dressed in the full armor of God.

It is right, and a good and joyful thing always and everywhere to remember that we are not in a battle against flesh and blood. Dressed in the full armor of God let us rise with Christ. Let us fight the evil powers and principalities who rebuild walls of hostility between us and God.

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Come Lord, Jesus, come. Come dress us in the full armor of God.

Breaking the Bread: What does it mean that we are not in a battle against flesh? It means that the power of our shame, guilt, and blame was defeated by the power of God's mercy. Even as Jesus suffered our shame, guilt, and blame he prayed, Father, forgive them, they do not know what they are doing. Do you know how to dress yourself in the full armor of God? The armor is power to fight against Satan and attacks of evil.

Blessing the Cup: What does it mean that we are not in a battle against blood? Blood gives physical life to the body. Forgiveness frees us to live by Faith through the Spirit of God. Jesus said, "Into your hands I commit my Spirit." Do you know how to put on the belt of truth?

The Belt of Truth: There is only ONE truth! It is called the Gospel. The Son of man suffered, he died, and rose again. It is also called the belt of grace, or belt of God's unconditional love. God places it around your waist; the seat of fear, shame, guilt, and blame.

The Breast Plate of Righteousness: God's truth saves us. The Belt of Truth reminds us that we are the Righteousness of God. Forgiveness sets us free from our neighbors judgment. The righteous are children of God, not the world's, and never the slave of neighbor or institution.

The Gospel of Peace on Our Feet: Jesus, our Lord, tells us to follow His way of truth and righteousness. We are to go into the world and proclaim the Victory. Wherever people are arguing, suffering, fighting, or in fear that God does not love them we are called to proclaim the Gospel of Truth. The Righteousness of God makes Peace with sinners of every kind. The truth is patient.

The Shield of Faith: Just because we are the righteousness of God, we must never think the battle with evil and Satan's temptation is over. Our battle is with powers and principalities. Satan tempted Jesus in every way. He roams like a lion seeking to devour God's righteous children. We fight by faith in the truth of Jesus Christ. We fight with Mercy, Faith, Hope, and Love.

The Helmet of Salvation: Have the same mind that was in Christ Jesus. God has chosen his people to be Holy and Blameless in His sight. We are saved by Grace, through faith in the truth that makes us righteous. Do not fall from grace as many have done and are doing!

The Sword of the Spirit: The Bible is a double edged sword! One edge is the Old Testament. The other edge is the New Testament. God never places a sword in a child's hand. The foolish child will use it to the destruction of self and neighbor. Before we take up the Sword of God's Word and approach our neighbor, God warns that we must be dressed as Christ in the full armor of God.

And so, in remembrance of these mighty acts, we proclaim the truth of Jesus Christ. Christ suffered! Christ died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again!

Come. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Come, dress us in the full armor of God. Dress us each day until we know how to dress ourselves and reveal your glory.
