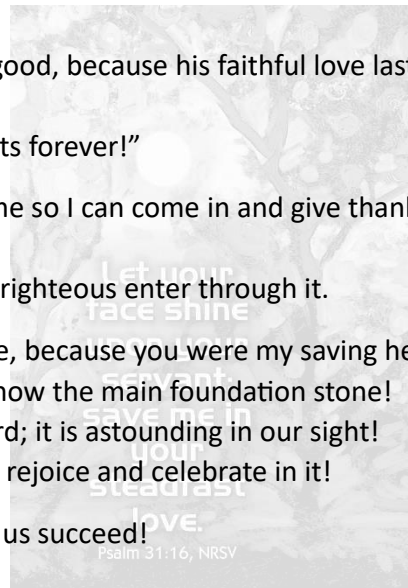

With the electronic method, you will need to establish an account prior to your first gift. Afterwards, you can simply sign in to your account.
