


## Treasurer Now Available at an Earlier Time on Thursdays

I know that you have heard me mention the Shepherd Team, but I believe that many of you still do not know what this team does. Let me share some specifics:

- This team reviews attendance patterns at the Sunday morning worship service. Those that are absent get calls or notes from the Team letting you know that you have been missed.
- This team visits members in their homes and in the hospital.
- This team talks with me about pastoral needs and issues that they might have discovered through one of the visits or phone conversations that they might make.
- This team is focused on providing ministries to those persons that are members of our church.
- This team talks about issues of hospitality and receives training articles to help them be better equipped to carry out their ministry of care and concern for our members.
- This team makes sure that the Grief Kits are stocked and ready to use when there is a death within the church or in the community.
- This team occasionally takes meals to our members if they are sick or unable to make a meal.
- This team keeps in contact with our homebound members.
- This team is lovingly concerned about each and every person related to the Trinity UMC.

If you have been listening over the last few months, you will have heard me say on numerous occasions, that my prayer life has been on an upswing due to an app that I use on my telephone. The app is called PrayerMate and is available on both android and apple platforms. The church has now teamed up with PrayerMate and from within the app, you can create a link to the Prayer Blog that is found on our web site.

I am encouraging you to download this app to your phone or tablet and begin using it. The app is totally customizable and allows you to create categories and within categories you can create subjects. Think of it in this way. Imagine you had a large recipe card box. In the box were dividers and within each section their were individual cards. Those individual cards would represent the person or situation for which you were praying and the dividers would represent categories or types of prayers.

In my system, I have the following categories (divisions): My Family, My Church, My Church Leaders, Homebound Members, etc. Within each of those sections I have specific cards for specific individuals and/or families. On each card is information specific to that individual. So, it's a simple concept. Basically it's a card file on steroids and I can keep it with me wherever I go.


Let me be honest, it does require a little while to set things up. After all, you have to create the sections and the cards in each section. In the end, however, you will be rewarded for your efforts by having a stronger prayer life. I know that I have been.

One other feature allows you to pull in feeds from established ministries.. That is the part that excites me at the moment. For months I have been reading the feeds of other Christian ministries and praying for events facing Christianity, often on a global basis. I have enjoyed daily devotions and prayers from a site called Heavenward. Now, our church is listed as one of those links that can be viewed directly from the PrayerMate app. I think this opens up a possibility of options for us in terms of corporate prayer. My goal is to post our Sunday Prayer Concerns each week. My goal is to also offer a weekly devotional or instructional moment focused on some aspect of prayer.

I need for you to download this app, personalize it, link to the Trinity United Methodist Church feed and begin to pray more intentionally for those persons and situations that you find in your life.

If you have any questions about the app and how to use it, then by all means get in touch with me. I'd love to sit down with you and show you how to use it. I truly think that you will be blessed and that our church will be blessed as one more person becomes more involved in prayer.
