

UMYF Needs Your Help With a Lock-in



One of the cards is for husbands and it contains a prayer that I have been praying on a regular basis for my wife Debbie now for several months. As a husband, I strongly encourage other husbands within the congregation to take seriously their role in praying for their spouse. A Prayer for Your Wife reminds you of how precious and valuable she is and I felt it an appropriate kind of prayer to include on Mother's Day. (By the way, we are going to have a similar prayer on Father's Day for wives to pray for their husbands!)

The other prayer card :Prayer for Our Growing Children, is a prayer that I hope that both parents will begin to pray over their child(ren). As you read the prayer, you see that it is a prayer of balance. You are asking God to give your child just enough—but not too much of prosperity and adversity and a host of other things. I encourage parents to engage in faithful prayers for their children along these lines.
