Pastor Taking Some Time Off

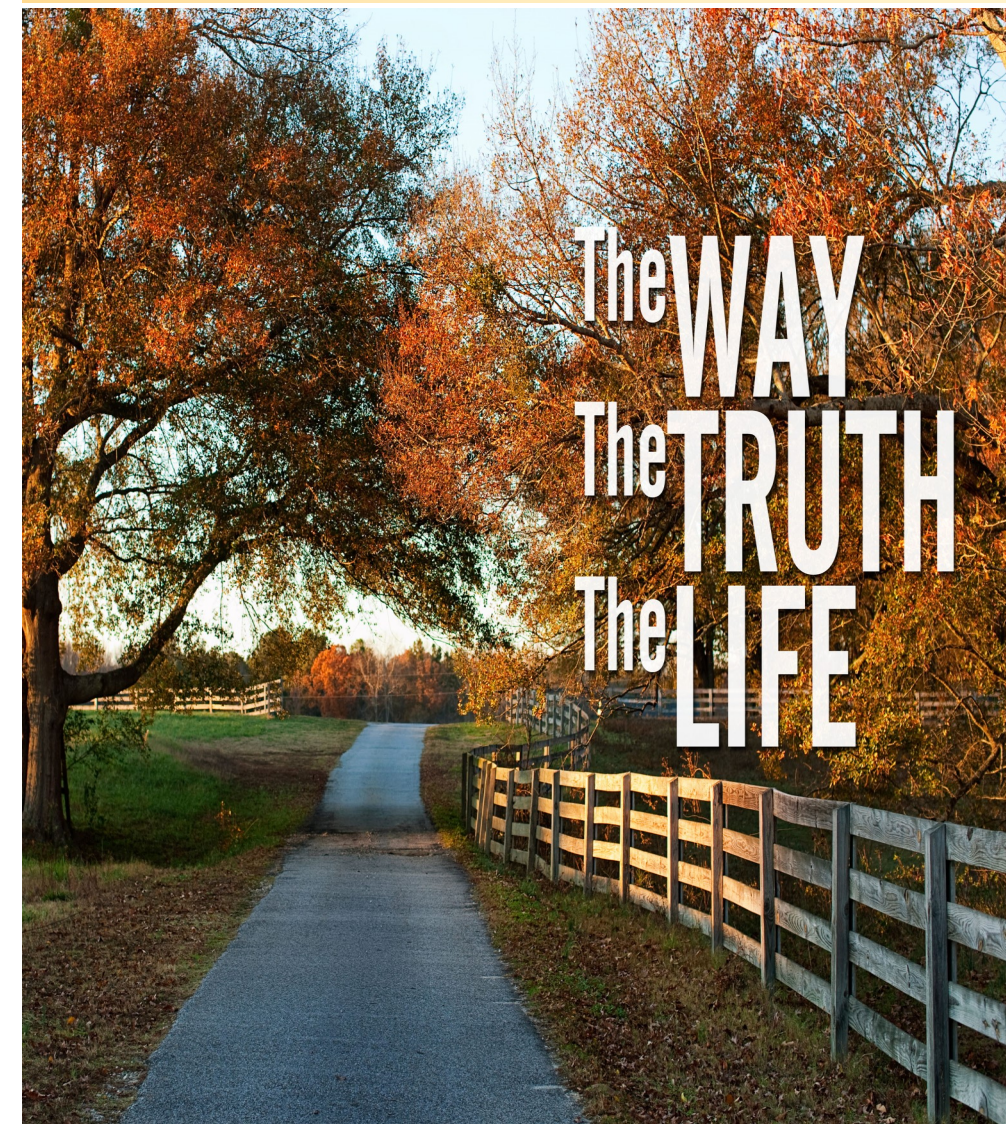
The week following Memorial Day, I will be taking some time off. Debbie's parents will be coming into town and I will be spending some time with them and the family.
