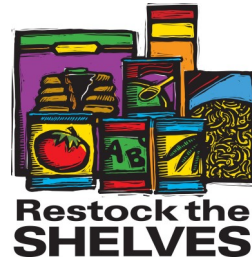


UPS Back Pack Program

Sunday June 17th—Pastor Burlingham's first worship service preaching.

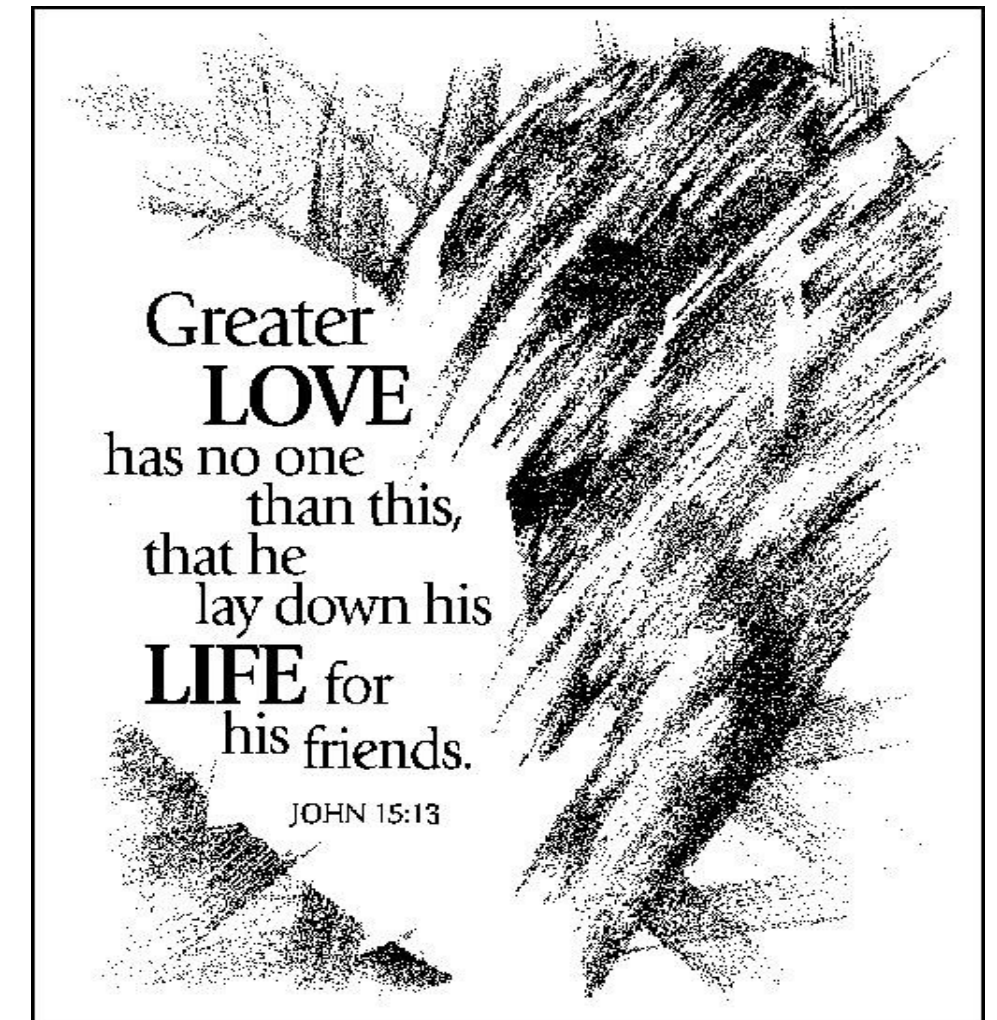
Sunday June 24th — after church — Pastor Burlingham will be preaching on this Sunday and we will be hosting a meal for him and his wife.
