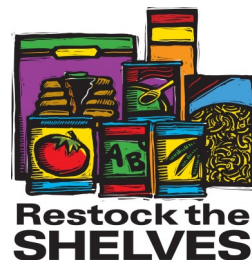


UPS Back Pack Program

Sunday June 17th—Happy Father's Day!! Pastor Robert's first week as a guest speaker.

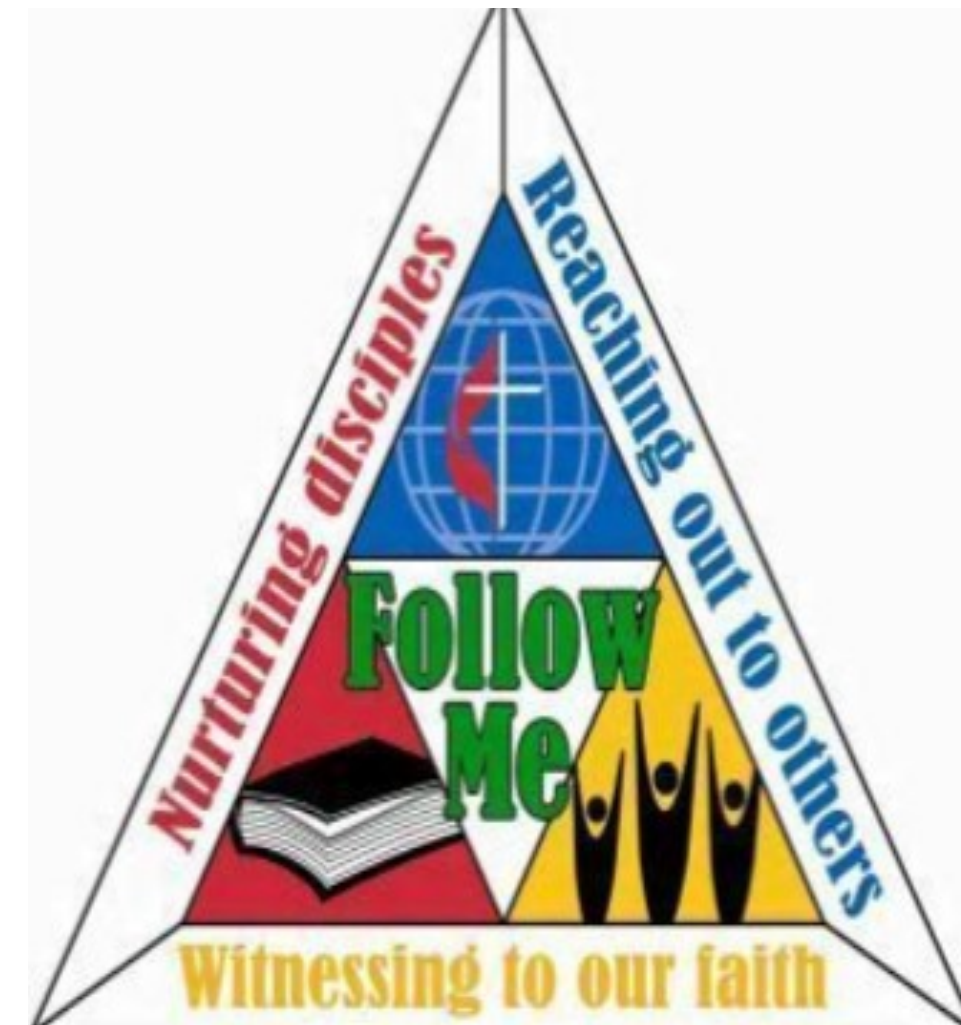
