Medical Update on Pastor Goodman

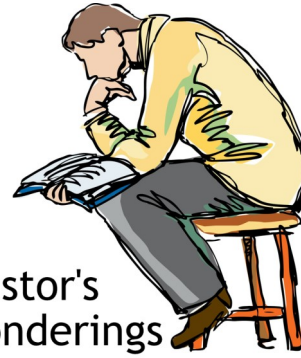

Report from the Administrative Board

We had a great Administrative Board meeting this past Sunday night. At our board meetings, we talk about lots of things related to the life of the church. As you might remember, last year was a difficult year for us financially as a church. We tightened our belts considerably and developed a budget that we thought would be appropriate for our church in 2016. At our Board meeting, we discussed our current financial situation through the end of May 2016.

The Board, would like to share some simple information about our current financial status. First of all, we have had three surplus months during the first five months of the year. That means we took in more money, than we had to expend. However, year to date we have had to spend about \$1,350 more than we have taken in. Secondly, when you compare giving to the General Fund through the end of May in 2015 through that same period in 2016 we are happy to report that our income is up by \$3,629. This indicates, that giving levels have increased over 2015 and for that we are extremely grateful.

The Administrative Board, though, wants to remind everyone that the summer months are typically slow months in terms of giving. We know that people go on vacations and tend to be in church less often. We have a simple request. We are asking you to plan ahead, and, if you will not be in church on a Sunday you were planning on giving, please make an effort to get that gift to the church prior to leaving. We want everyone to have a relaxed summer, but we also need to keep cash flow even on a year-round basis. It is difficult for instance to recover from a slow summer when the fall months begin. So, please keep this request in mind and have a great summer but don't forget the church is still in mission and ministry doing things on your behalf and your gift will be used to help make that possible.

The Administrative Board would also like to give a special thanks to those persons that use a bank draft each month from their bank account. This method of giving, helps to even out cash flow throughout the year. By having an automatic draft sent to the church it doesn't matter if you're on vacation or if you miss a Sunday. That gift will be received and we will be able to continue ministry without worrying about cash flow issues. This is a simple process that can be set up easily with your bank. If you are interested in doing this, all you need to do is contact your bank or go online and set it up through your online banking portal.

Thank you for your continued giving. Your gifts allow us to make a difference in the lives of many different people. God's love is being spread abroad and people are coming to know Jesus Christ. Your gift helps to make that possible.
