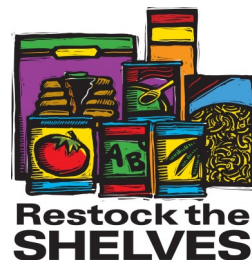


UPS Back Pack Program

Wednesday August 1—The Fellowship dinner will be held at 6:30 pm.

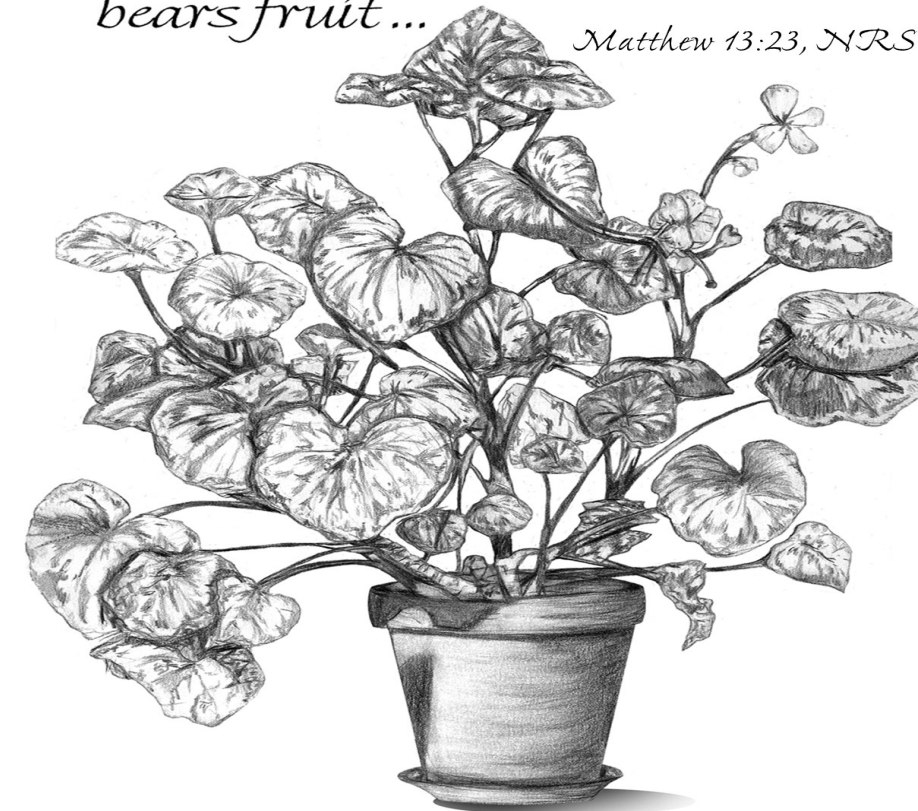
