They have been viewed a total of 72,022 times for a total of 107,840 minutes (1797 hours). We have 85 subscribers (people that like the channel so much they have bookmarked it). Another 666 people have liked something on the channel enough to share it with someone that they know. The number one most watched video is one of the congregation singing "In the Garden" it has been viewed 7396 times. I get reports from some of you that people in other states regularly view our service. All this costs us is the monthly internet connection that we use at the church. You can reach a lot of people with a small investment.
