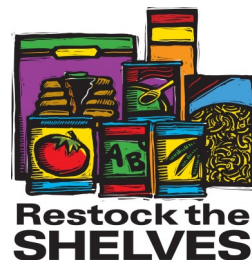


UPS Back Pack Program
