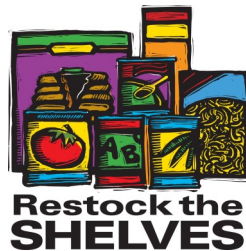

The food item for August is Soup. The flavors requested are Chicken Noodle or Tomato.


