

# How to Pray for the Election

## Part 4

This is the final installment for this series.

8. Pray for a spirit of repentance to fall upon the Church in America that would cause us to turn back to God and seek Him. (2 Cor. 5:10)

<sup>10</sup>because we must all stand before Christ to be judged. Each of us will receive what we should get—good or bad—for the things we did in the earthly body.

9. Pray for a spirit of courage to rise within the Church. Commit to enduring whatever it takes to see the fulfillment of God's purposes in our nation. (1 Thess.1:6)

<sup>6</sup>And you became like us and like the Lord. You suffered much, but still you accepted the teaching with the joy that comes from the Holy Spirit.

10. Pray that the Church in America will live in such a way that the peace of Christ comes into the councils of our nation. (Rom.12:2)

<sup>2</sup>Do not be shaped by this world; instead be changed within by a new way of thinking. Then you will be able to decide what God wants for you; you will know what is good and pleasing to him and what is perfect.

11. Pray for a movement of the Spirit that creates a dramatic cultural transformation in the United States, bringing about a nation that has learned to put its hope in the Word of God. (Matt. 4:16)

<sup>16</sup>These people who live in darkness will see a great light. They live in a place covered with the shadows of death, but a light will shine on them.

12. Ask the Lord to awaken the Church to the temporary nature of the nations and to the eternal nature of the reign of God. (Matt. 6:33)

<sup>33</sup>Seek first God's kingdom and what God wants. Then all your other needs will be met as well.

13. Pray that courage born of wisdom will be given to Christians in places of leadership in government, the courts, and law schools across the nation so that they will stand for a godly basis for law. (Joshua 1:9)

<sup>9</sup>Remember that I commanded you to be strong and brave. Don't be afraid, because the LORD your God will be with you everywhere you go.

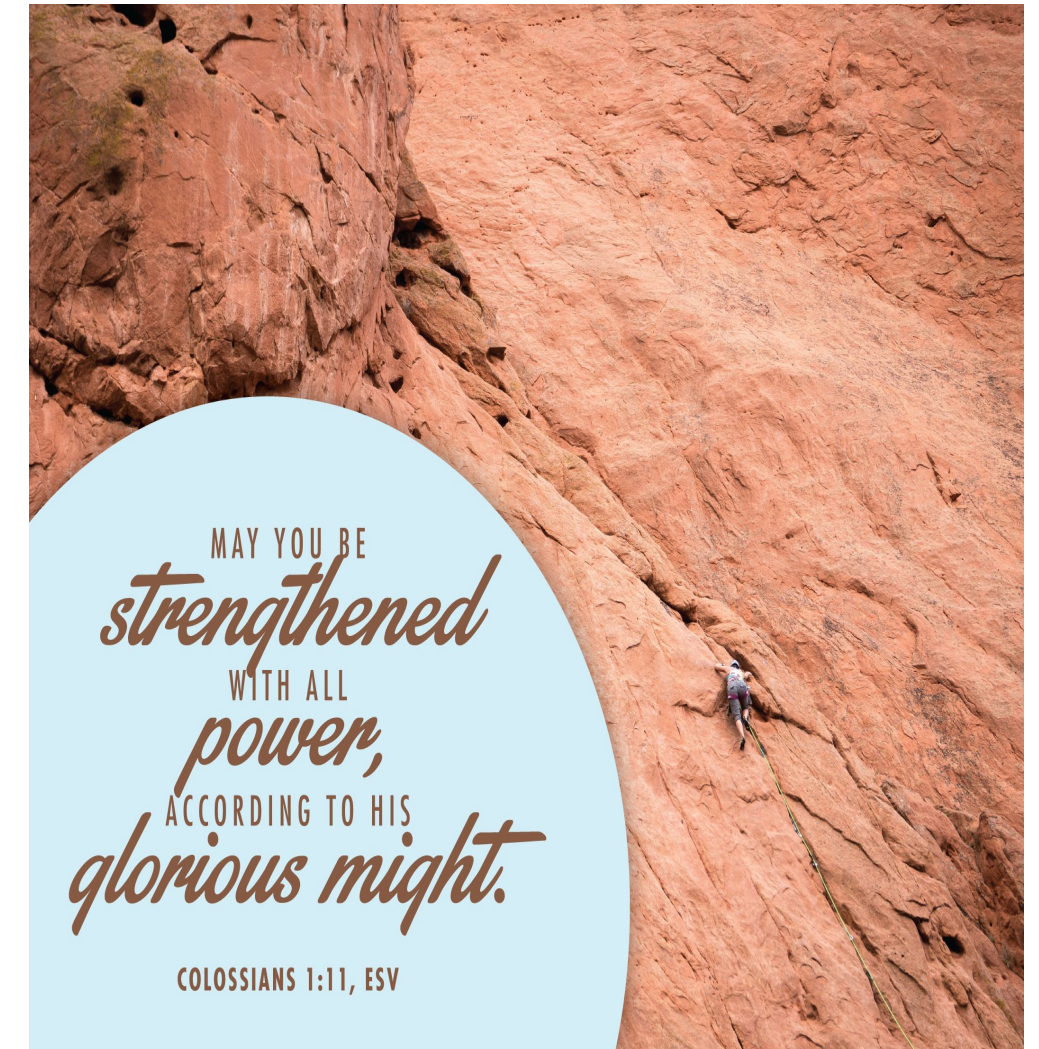
### Trunk or Treat

## The Corporate Nature of Prayer — A Commentary

### Call to Confession

When we pray, we speak to God.

When we pray, God speaks to us.

Let us, therefore, enter into dialogue with our creator.

### Prayer of Confession *(in unison)*

We confess without reservation that our dialogue with you, O God, is not really a dialogue. Most often, we are asking without listening and complaining without offering thanksgiving. We pray, and cannot understand why we get no response. Awaken us to wonder: If you called, would we answer? Or would you get a busy signal? Would you leave a message, and get no answer in return? We confess anew our impatience and our unwillingness to sit in the holy stillness of your presence. Forgive us, loving God. Thank you for letting us try again. In this minute of silence, let us be still and listen to what you would say to us this day.

*(One minute of silent prayer)*

### Assurance of Pardon

Pastor: Even when we try and fail again and again, God loves us still. In the richness of God's grace, we accept the peace of Christ, which passes all understanding. Amen.

*( You will be given an opportunity to share joys and prayer concerns. Please raise your hand and wait until an usher comes to you with a microphone.)*

*After each petition is said, we will all then say: Lord. Hear Our Prayer.*

*After all have lifted up their petitions, the Pastor will then say...*

Pastor: Let us pray for one another without ceasing!

**People: Pray that we will abide in the True Vine and, thus, bear fruit for God's kingdom.**

Pastor: Pray that we will draw strength from the power of God's Spirit.

**People: Pray that we will patiently endure hardships and suffering.**

Pastor: Pray that we will joyfully embrace all our circumstances, giving thanks to God always.

**People: Pray that faith, love and hope will be the hallmarks of our lives.**

Pastor: We pray in this way because we belong to God our Father.

**People: God has rescued us from sin, darkness and evil.**

Pastor: God has made us heirs of God's kingdom.

**People: Can you believe it? We share God's inheritance with all the saints of every time and place!**

Pastor: We are redeemed, forgiven of all our sins and loved with an everlasting love.

**People: All praise, glory and honor to God -- Father, Son and Holy Spirit! Amen.**
