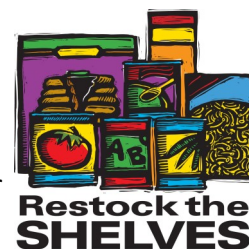


UPS Back Pack Program

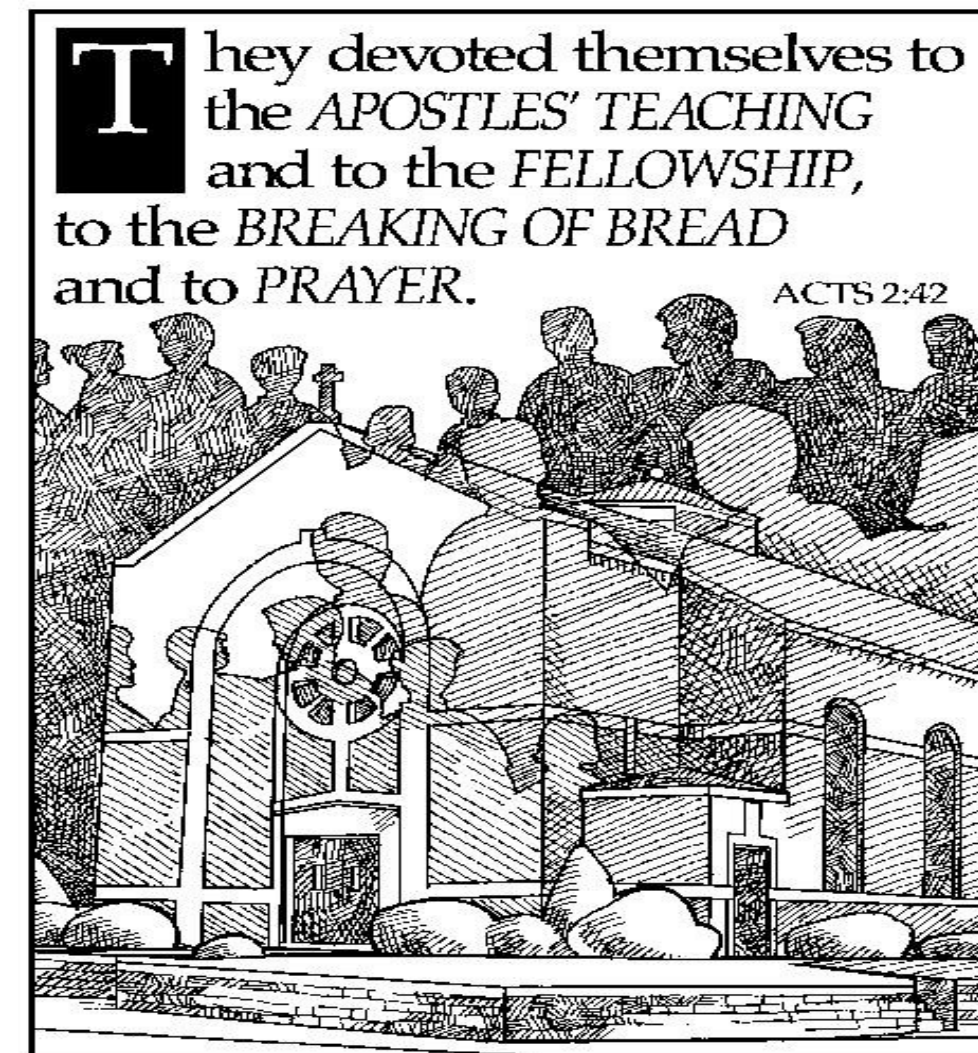

Yes, I will place my Faith in Christ alone, but with the Living— Hope that my neighbor will experience in me love beyond all reason, judgment, and condemnation.
