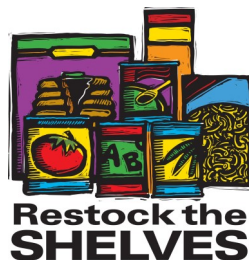


UPS Back Pack Program

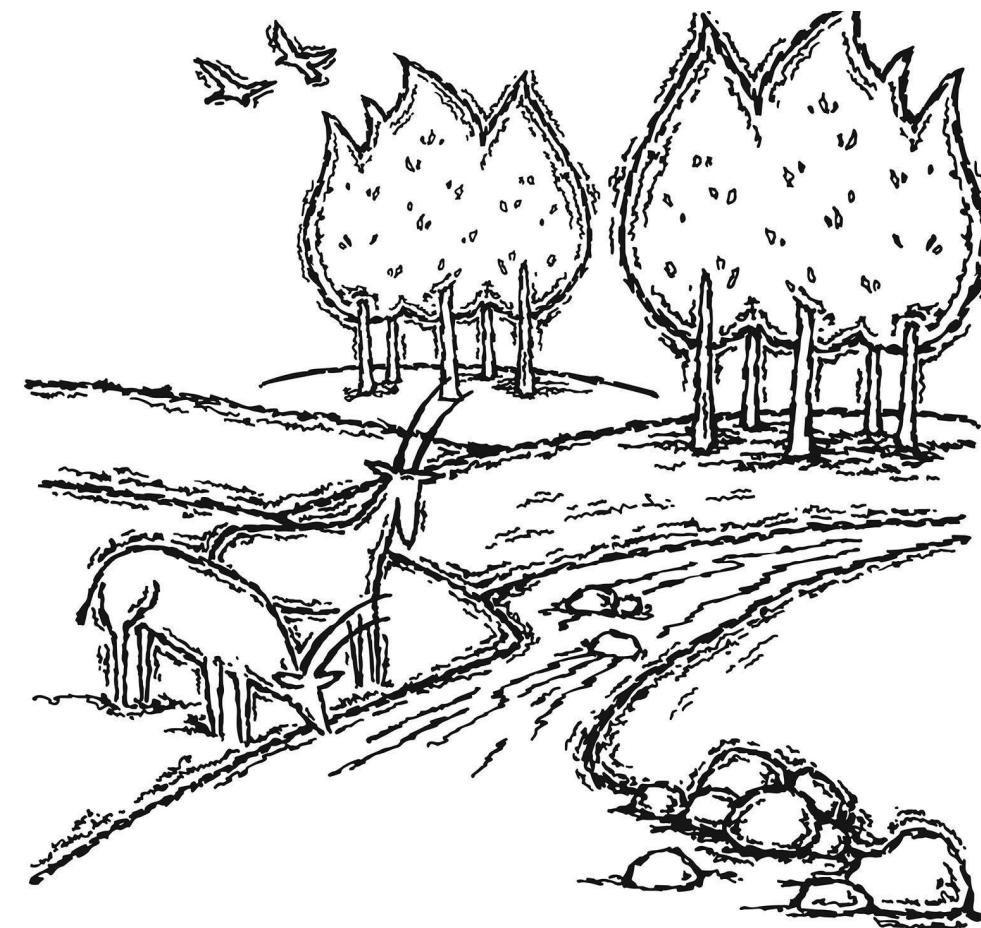
