Lighting the Advent Candle—The Goodman Family

Leader: We light this candle in HOPE. [The candle is lit.]
We bring this light of hope with us, together, on this journey. Hope comes from the Child and our hope is dedicated to the Child lying in a manger. Seeking goodness only, for our neighbors and for ourselves, may we kindle God's light

The first verse of "O Little Town of Bethlehem" will be sung in response.

"O little town of Bethlehem, how still we see thee lie; Above thy deep and dreamless sleep the silent stars go by. Yet in they dark streets shineth the everlasting light; The hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee tonight."
