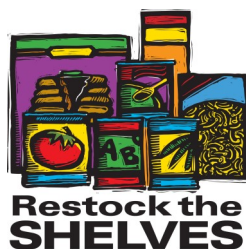


UPS Back Pack Program

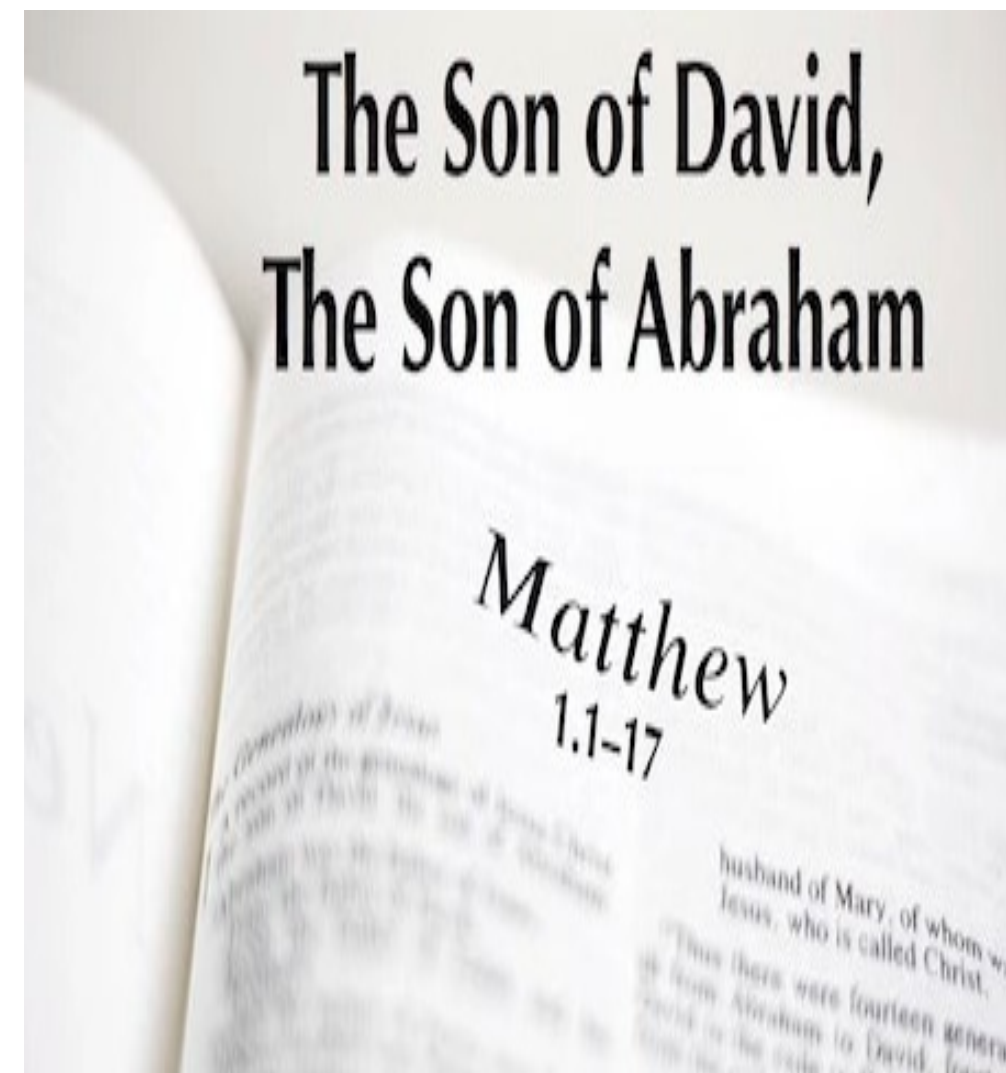

The Promise

Do you remember God's Promise? A promise gives the gift of Hope. God promised Abraham a son. That son would make of him a great nation. God PROMISED that all the families of the earth would be blessed through Him.
