

God's Promise

The very nature of a promise demands that we wait on the one who made it.

God promised to make of Abraham a Great Nation. God promised King David a Son who would sit on his throne eternally. The Great Nation promised to Abraham is The Kingdom of Heaven. The King promised to David is Jesus Christ. God *promised* that this Great Nation would be a blessing to all the families of the earth.
