Advent 2022—Advent is the period of preparation for Christmas, which begins on December 25th. The Sundays leading up to December 24th are the Sundays of Advent with the final day being December 24th.

To help you reflect and celebrate Advent, you should notice a wreath surrounded by four exterior candles and one central candle. The four exterior candles represent the hallmarks of a renewed creation: joy, hope, peace, and love. The central candle represents the presence of Christ. Each Sunday, one more of the exterior candles is lit. Finally, the Christ candle is lit as a reminder of Christ’s ongoing presence.

Each week, we light a new candle in the Advent wreath as well as the candles from the preceding week. The candles represent Hope (purple), Love (purple), Joy (pink), and Peace (purple). The white candle represents Christ and will be lit on Christmas Eve.

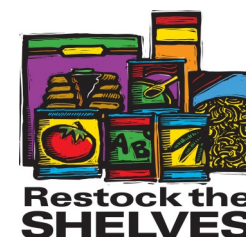
Youth and Children’s Spotlight—

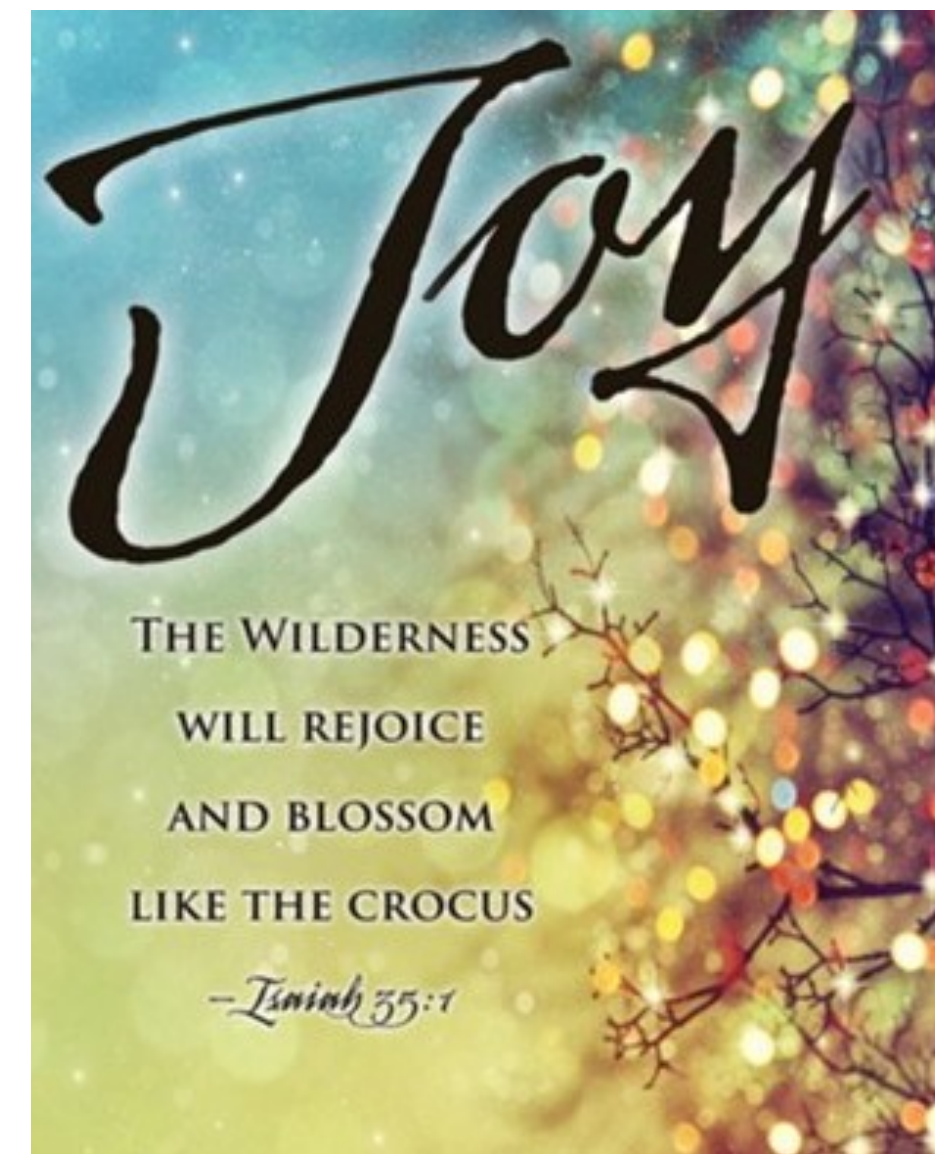
Don’t forget that each month we are going to Restock the Shelves for the Union Primary School. During the month of December, the requested item is Juice Boxes.
