Pastor and Family Going on Vacation

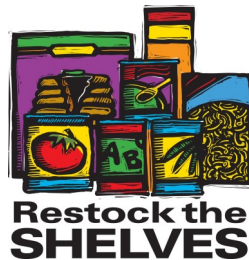
