maker of heaven and earth; And in Jesus Christ his only Son, our Lord;


who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,

Preparation to Hear God's Word

Open my eyes, that I may see glimpses of truth thou hast for me; place in my hand the wonderful key that shall unclasp and set me free.

Silently now I wait for THEE!

Andrea Crouch lead us to sing, "Through it all, through it all, I've learned to trust in Jesus."

Naming "it all" leads to confession.

Confession prepares us to pray with God about specifics. By such prayer we learn to depend on God's Word. Jesus is the Word. The power of his name is Mercy, Grace, and Love

- 21 After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. 2 Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin,[a] Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. 3 Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will go with you." They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.
- 4 Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. 5 Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" They answered him, "No." 6 He said to them, "Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. 7 That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the sea. 8 But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards[b] off.

Silently now I wait for Thee, Ready my God, Thy Will to SEE!

John's Gospel has opened my mind and heart to see Three Changes in the Christian Life. You remember that Repentance means to change our thinking. Therefore, I see Repentance leads to Changes in our thinking, feeling, and being.

- 1. **Obedience.** We have learned to be obedient to the Law of Moses. Obedience to the Ten Commandments and the Levitical Code does exactly what God planned. It convicts us of our sinful nature and creates fear of death.
 - 1. John 1: 17 says, "For the Law was given through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ."
 - 2. Paul speaks of changing our obedience from the Law of Moses to Christ Jesus. Galatians 3: 2, "Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the Law, or by hearing with Faith?"
 - 3. Repentance fulfills the Law of Moses! Let us CHANGE our hearts and minds.

- 4. Let us be Obedient to Christ and his Mercy.
- 2. **Faith.** Paul's question in Galatians 3:2 asks, "In whom do you place your faith. Who do you trust for salvation? Do you trust Moses or Jesus. SELF?
 - 1. Jesus warns us that we cannot serve two masters.
 - 2. The Second Change to take place in the Christian Life is to turn from Moses to Jesus.
 - 3. Faith always trust someone other than self. Faith always denies self to follow another. Are you following Moses, Jesus, or both? No wonder the UMC house is divided!!!
 - 4. Let us be faithful to Christ and His Grace.
- 3. Love. Jesus sends His disciples to Love as He has loved us.
 - 1. Love with out Obedience to Christ's mercy is self-righteousness.
 - 2. Love with our Faith in Jesus Christ is Cheap Grace.
 - 3. Love is patient, humble and merciful. Love never insist on its way, it abides in Christ's Grace. Love offers Hope in all Thing. "Through it all, I've learned to trust in Jesus."

Friends, every Change has its barriers. In John's Gospel I see three barriers. The Good News is that barriers test our beliefs, strengthen our faith in Christ, and teach us to love one another as Christ loves us.

The Three Barriers the Disciples Faced:

- 1. **Fear of the Jews:** John 20:19 **19** When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you."
 - 1. Why fear the Jews. Remember John 1:17. God gave the Law through Moses. The Law reveals Sin. The religious leaders used the Law to accuse, judge, and sentence Jesus to the penalty of Sin, death. The Disciples feared they were next.
 - 2. Fear of the Law of Moses is a barrier to Obedience to Christ's Mercy.
- 2. Doubt: John 20:24-25 24 But Thomas (who was called the Twin[c]), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. 25 So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."
 - 1. We all have doubts. My experience of doubt comes when my mind is focused in one direction while my heart focuses in another direction. Doubt is like a wave of the sea.
 - 2. I hear this in Thomas' words. I will not believe until I see. Seeing leads the mind to believe. I will not believe until I place my fingers in Jesus' wounds. Touching leads the heart/feelings to confirm what the mind sees and believes. Ergo, doubt is self-focused. It is works righteous.

- **3.** Mary doubted until she heard Jesus call he by name.
- 4. The Disciples doubted Mary's witness until they experienced Jesus themselves.
- **5.** Thomas does the same thing as Mary and the Disciples.
- **6.** Doubt is a barrier to faith in Christ's Grace. Doubt is self focused and or leads. To faith in someone other than Jesus.
- 3. Career/Profession/Job: John 21:1-8 After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. 2 Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin,[a] Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. 3 Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will go with you." They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.
 - 1. The Disciples were mostly Fishermen. They went back to what they knew. So it is with us. (The politicians can't wait to get us back to work!)
 - 1. Success is a blessing but can and does become a barrier.
 - **2.** Power is a blessing. God Graciously gives us the Holy Spirit, the power of the Gospel, but power can and does become a barrier.
 - 3. Wealth is a blessing but it can and does become a barrier.
 - 2. Notice that Jesus meets the disciples at their barriers to. Lead them into the Kingdom of Heaven.

I share this outline only to serve as a road map for the next three weeks. In coming weeks let us humble ourselves. Humility is the courage to sit down and listen. Humility patiently and mercifully listens to the Fear of the Jews, The Doubts of our inner Thomas, and our compulsion to return to the work that convinces us that we are self- sustaining.

As Andrae Crouch sings, Through it all, I've learn to trust in Jesus. I've learned to trust God's word. Let us Learn!
