The Lord's Prayer

Hearing the Word: Matthew 9

27 As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!"

28 When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?"

"Yes, Lord," they replied.

- 29 Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith let it be done to you"; 30 and their sight was restored. Jesus warned them sternly, "See that no one knows about this." 31 But they went out and spread the news about him all over that region.
- **32** While they were going out, a man who was demon-possessed and could not talk was brought to Jesus. **33** And when the demon was driven out, the man who had been mute spoke. The crowd was amazed and said, "Nothing like this has ever been seen in Israel."
- **34** But the Pharisees said, "It is by the prince of demons that he drives out demons."

The Message: Who Do You Believe for Life?

Two blind men approach Jesus saying, "Have mercy on us, Son of David." The two blind men have ears that hear. They heard Jesus say, I desire mercy, not sacrifice. How many times must we hear Jesus before we desire mercy?

The two blind men heard Jesus. Their desire for mercy opened their eyes to see Jesus' true identity. They called him, Son of David. Messiah. God's promised Son who would be King forever.

Jesus asked the two blind men, do you believe I can do this. Do you believe God's mercy heals the Blindness caused by Sin?

I hear Jesus asking the two blind men:

Do you believe me, or The Teachers of the Law? Do you believe me, or the Pharisees? Do you believe me, or the Disciples of John the Baptist? Do you want to be like them, or the Synagogue Leader?

I am thankful for the Law of Moses. It teaches me that a sinner desires to be right and good. The Teachers of the Law blind me. They teach me to judge my self, neighbor, and God. Having seen and heard Jesus, they judged him a blasphemer.

I am thankful for ethics, morals, and spiritual disciplines. Imagine how selfish and entitled people would be without them. The Pharisees blind me. They convince me the way to keep the Law is to train myself to be right and good. The Pharisees and the Disciples of John the Baptist judged Jesus to be of Satan.

Jesus asked the two blind men, "Do you believe I can do this?" IN other words, Jesus wants to know who they trust. Faith in Jesus demands we deny self. Faith in Jesus demands we deny the Teachers of the Law, Pharisees, and Disciples of John the Baptist.

Faith in Jesus means we deny judgement to desire mercy.

Faith in Jesus means we deny works righteousness to desire God.

Jesus says, "The wise person hears my word and acts on it." Do not be alarmed when Teachers of the Law call you a blasphemer. Do do be shocked when the Pharisees whisper that the work you do is of Satan.

Jesus says, Blessed are those who are persecuted and reviled because of righteousness.
